Kim began working in the Domestic Violence arena in 1996 and began the Forensic Nurse Examiner program in Maricopa County in 1998. Kim was a member of the Governor's Sexual Assault Task Force, Maricopa County Task Forces for Domestic Violence, Elder Abuse, Sexual Assault, and Child Abuse, as well as a member of the development team for the State of Arizona Recommended Guidelines Coordinated Community Response to Sexual Assault.

Kim currently has management responsibility for the Forensic Nurse Examiner Unit, which is a team of 15 Forensic Nurse Examiners that services Maricopa and Pinal counties in Arizona , approximately 3 million people. This includes the Phoenix-metro area. The program sees approximately 100 clients each month, and includes domestic violence, sexual violence (all ages), elder abuse, and suspect collection.
