# Adult/Adolescent Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner

## Course Description:

This five day comprehensive introductory course is designed to provide the health care professional with the skills to perform a complete assessment and evaluation, as well as treatment, evidence recognition, collection, and courtroom testimony for the Adult/Adolescent sexual assault patient.

## Who Should Attend:

The course is designed for health care professionals providing medical/forensic examinations for the adult/adolescent sexual assault patient. Also, any member of the community resource team that advocates, investigates or plays a role in the judicial process.

## Objectives:

- Define the community response concept and role delineation of the members
- Discuss the roles and responsibilities of the Healthcare Professional
- Explain Rape Trauma Syndrome; Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
- Comprehend the steps of the medical / forensic sexual assault evaluation for adult/adolescent female and male patient
- Identify the impact of the medical /forensic evaluation on the investigation
- Recognize the impact of the medical / forensic documentation and need for precision
- Identify the importance of accurate forensic evidence; recognition, collection, & preservation
- Recognize various profiles of the offender
- Demonstrate knowledge and skills in effective courtroom testimony
